The National Museum of the Air Force arranged special tours for 100 of us. We have two identical tours of 50 folks each to get a "behind the scenes" look at the aircraft refurbishment process. When you sign up for the NMUSAF tours, you will receive a confirmation letter from Ron Julian. While the tour is free, there is a \$7.50 per person charge for the bus transportation from the hotel to the Restoration Hangar & return. Folks who register early for the tour have first shot at the restoration tour slots (you will be assigned to a tour based on the order of your sign ups). You visit an on-base hanger where the museum refurbishes & restores airplanes, missiles, & other items.

You must have a Driver's license to go on this tour (secure access to the base); Military ID is not accepted.

From the overlook vista, you see Huffman Prairie where Orville & Wilbur developed the first practical airplane. You meet with a Park Ranger, tour the visitor's center, then travel to Carillon Historical Park for an afternoon's exposure to the innovative contributions to our country's industrialization might from 1796 to present. You see the world's most complete collection of cash registers; learn about the "Barn Gang" & their impact on the fledgling auto industry in the early 1900s & to our budding military aviation.
