

# The National Museum of the United States Air Force

## Restoration Tour – Friday, September 29, 2017

Get a first-hand look at the aircraft restoration process as we take a special “Behind the Scenes” Tour at the NMUSAF. During the tour, we will be guided through the museum’s restoration hangar located on the historic Wright Field flight line of Wright Patt AFB. We will see the World War II B-17F bomber, *Memphis Belle*, in its final stage of restoration.



Participants must be at least 12 years old, An adult must accompany those under 18. A valid state driver’s license or state-issued ID card (with photo) is required of all individuals 18 & over. **Any foreign visitors must present an original passport (NEXUS cards & foreign enhanced driver’s licenses are not authorized).** For security reasons, all bags are subject to search. Backpacks, packages & large camera cases are not permitted on our bus. Bag checks may be conducted while enroute to the restoration hangar. The tour is primarily walking and standing - seating is very limited.



### Tour Registration

While the one-hour tour is free, there is a \$7.50 per person charge for the bus transportation from the hotel to the Restoration Hangar & return. This bus is the only method to get access to the Restoration Hanger for the tours. The NMUSAF arranged two identical tours of 50 folks each to get a “behind the scenes” look at the aircraft refurbishment process. Registration is limited to the first 100 people. You will receive a confirmation letter from Ron Julian. Folks who register earliest have first shot at the restoration tour slots (you will be assigned to a tour based on the order of your sign ups). **NOTE: Registration for this tour is separate from Reunion registration. You must have your driver’s license with you for access (your military ID will not be accepted.)**

- **Tour 1: (You will be assigned to a tour).**
  - 0830 - Bus loads at the Holiday Inn
  - ~0855 - Bus unloads at the Restoration Hanger
  - ~1015 - Bus loads at the Restoration Hanger
  - ~1040 - Bus unloads at the Holiday Inn
- **Tour 2: (You will be assigned to a tour).**
  - 0945 - Bus loads at the Holiday Inn
  - ~1010 - Bus unloads at the Restoration Hanger
  - ~1120 - Bus loads at the Restoration Hanger
  - ~1145 - Bus unloads at the Holiday Inn
