*“The Museum tells the history of the Vietnam People’s Air Force (VPAF) in the
Second Indochina War and the Cambodian-Vietnamese War.”*

*“The museum comprises one main building with a small display of uniforms and
flightsuits, aircraft weaponry and engines.”*

*“Outside is a static park with aircraft of the VPAF and the Republic of Vietnam Air
Force.”*

*“The museum is open Tuesday-Thursday and weekends from 07:30 to 11:00 and
13:30 to 17:00. Admission is free.”*
