## THE VIETNAM CENTER AND ARCHIVE Texas Tech University

Researching Online (Digital Materials) The Vietnam Archive currently has over 400,000 items (over 3.2 million pages) available online in a digital format. Types of materials digitized include documents & manuscripts, still & moving images, audio recordings, oral histories, maps, artifacts, & more. New items are being made available online daily. To assist researchers, we have provided a variety of ways to access these digital materials. Search Pages The primary method for accessing digital materials is the Virtual Vietnam Archive search engine. The Virtual Vietnam Archive is the name of our complete digitization project, & this search page allows users to search all the materials in the Virtual Archive, including our collection Finding Aids, which are listings of the contents of our physical collections. By including finding aids in the Virtual Archive, we allow users to search across our entire holdings, both the individually digitized items, & collections that have not yet been digitized. Note that some items in the Virtual Archive will not be available to users outside of our building due to copyright issues. There are also search pages available for some specific collections. The most significant is the Maps Collection search page. While the map collection is available in the Virtual Archive, the maps search page gives researchers some more specific search options, such as searching by latitude & longitude. Search pages are also available for the Graffiti Project Canvas Bunk Bottom Collection, our Operations Database of over 1300 operations conducted in Southeast Asia, & for names included in the Families of Vietnamese Political Prisoners Association Collection (operations & FVPPA Collection names are not available through the Virtual Archive search page).
