Final Flight Updates & Challenges

We worked for the last two years to make our Master Contact List (MCL) and Website easier to keep up with, both for you as the readers/users, and a small group of volunteers who labor to keep those accurate and up to date: your Association's Board, Committee Members, Project Leads, and Points Of Contact (POC).

During that year we also had several challenges for many of those Volunteers – health and family wise.

And, for about two years, we've done Outreach to find more names we remember, but who we have no contact with. We found hundreds so far, and our Facebook site has also brought many more to us. But, we all too often sadly learn that many of those "lost" brothers had already died, some many years ago, some more recently.

When one of our AC-119ers passes on, our priority is to make contact with the family to express our support and remind them we (all of us) care – a lot – about each other. Our brotherhood will always be about that. We also try to let everyone know as much of the Funeral or memorial details as we can - Mail call and FaceBook help us do that. Many losses occurred in the last year, and we learned that many passed on years ago. While this update of those we lost can sadden, it reinforces how important it is to stay in touch with each other. "Brothers Forever" is not a catchy phrase we toss around – it is the truth of our brotherhood. We can't bring them back but we can remember them here, on our Web's Final Flight page, and in our hearts.

So, the good news: we found hundreds of lost contacts and we celebrate that. We continue to do Outreach to find the hundreds of other lost AC-119ers still out there. You can help by going to our Alpha Roster and updating it with names you remember, or contacts you might have that we don't. Our Web and MCL will be automated soon (even if you don't hear them, please know the Volunteers are cheering loudly about that) It will soon be much easier for us to maintain and update the Web, MCL, Reunion info, merchandise, etc!!

As Paul Harvey says, "the rest of the story" is that we mourn for the ones we found who are no longer able to meet with us at Reunions. They are gone in body, but not forgotten. The list to the right are the brothers who we learned took their Last Flight, and whose names were not yet included in previous Association Newsletters or News Flash messages. Rest well, Brothers.

Vietnam Wall of Faces

Are you familiar with the Vietnam War Memorial's Virtual Wall of Faces (WOF)? If you are, you know that the Virtual Wall of Faces features a page for every person whose name is on the Vietnam Memorial. These interactive pages allow family and friends to share memories, post pictures and connect with each other. Our association's website lists 17 names of our KIA brothers. Of those 17, 5 do NOT have a photo posted on the "WOF". We are working with the families of several of those to post the picture(s) they want: Thomas R. Hamman, Joseph C. Jeszeck, Bernard R. Knapic, and Thomas L. Lubbers. We are also currently trying to locate the family of Robert F. Fage. We welcome photos of any of these men.

If you have any photos of them, please scan and send them to both Lee Kyser at ac119k@earthlink.net and Wayne Laessig at Qadvocate@ sbcglobal.net) and they will work with their families before posting anything. Also, if you have any info on Robert Fage's son Dewight, please contact Wayne. We lost contact with Dewight after he attended a



Reunion in Ft Walton several years ago. However, getting photos of those 5 is just a small niche on the Wall of Faces. There is a lady in Hawaii who has diligently dedicated her time toward getting photos posted for ALL of the U. S. military KIA. That number is in the thousands. The following is an abbreviated version of her request for assistance:

My name is Janna Hoehn. I am 25 year resident of Maui, Hawaii. The Vietnam War was the big news during my high school years. I never knew anyone who had been killed during that war, but I really wanted to see the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall. Six years ago, my husband and I made our first trip to Washington, DC. I wanted a rubbing of a person who was missing in action. I approached the Wall and selected the name Gregory John Crossman. When I returned home, I tried to find Crossman's family. The thought was that if they had never been to the Wall, I might be able to swap the rubbing for a family photo of Gregory. Unable to locate the family after six months, I contacted a cousin who knew how to search family

histories. Within six weeks she came up with a college photo of Gregory.

Two years passed, and I learned of the "Faces Never Forgotten" for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial fund. I sent Gregory's photo to them for posting. Five days later, I received a thank you from Jan Scruggs. Mr. Scruggs asked if I would assist in getting more photos of the 42 Maui County soldiers who had been killed. I was honored to do so. I learned very quickly it was going to be much more difficult to do than I had thought.

It wasn't until I approached the local newspaper, The Maui News, that I had any real success. I began getting calls and photos from all over the United States. Then The Maui News continued covering the subject every six weeks. That resulted in even more calls and photos. After six months all of the Maui County KIA photos had been obtained.

Having had so much success in Hawaii, I started with California newspapers. The response has been amazing! I have as well as the future Education Center being built adjacent to the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall.

Putting a face to a name changes the whole dynamic of the Wall. It will keep the memories of our heroes alive and assures their heroic stories and sacrifices will never be forgotten.

My plea is this: If you know of anyone who might have a photo of any of the KIA, please let them know how to contact me. If a photo isn't available, that person might know where the KIA went to school or where the relatives might live. There are 58,300 names on the Wall. Close to 19,000 do NOT have a photo posted.
