Friday, Sept. 18, TOUR.....Discovering St Louis is more than just the Arch. It is seeing the city's neighborhoods and some of its major attractions on a driving tour narrated by an experienced guide. Your professional Discover St Louis guide will meet your group at the hotel and depart with you for your city tour. We begin with Laclede's Landing, a nine block historic area named for the founder of the city. Driving through the cobblestone streets will bring you to the riverfront and to a view of the 630 foot tall Gateway Arch. You will see the oldest cathedral west of the Mississippi, the Old Courthouse where the Dred Scott case began, and Busch Stadium. Enjoy a historic drive through Soulard, the oldest surviving residential neighborhood in the city. The neighborhood centers around an outdoor market that dates from the 1700's. Another beautiful neighborhood to enjoy is Lafayette Park, which boasts the largest concentration of Victorian-era architecture in the nation and is also named one of the "ten prettiest painted lady neighborhoods" in the country by Better Homes and Gardens and Architecture magazines. Enjoy a tour at Anheuser Busch InBev Brewery where you will see the stables, cellar and brew house and enjoy a complimentary sample. Lunch today will be on your own at Favazza's Restaurant ((314) 492-3262 www.favazzas.com. Located in the famed Italian neighborhood known as "The Hill," you'll enjoy an authentic Italian lunch. We round out our day with a tour to the Cathedral Basilica, home to 84,000 square feet of mosaic tiles. (Cathedral is available based around mass, funeral and wedding schedules).

Cost for tour is \$33.00 per person based on a minimum of 25 people paid. Cost includes a luxury motor coach, a professional Discover St Louis tour guide, a tour at AB InBev Brewery, tour of Cathedral Basilica, and all arrangements and reservations. Lunch is on your own at Favazza's Restaurant. Gratuity to driver and guide is not included in the cost. Suggest a \$1 - \$2 per person for each guide and driver. The bus will pick up the tour attendee's at 9:30 AM, at the hotel and return to the hotel at 2:30 PM

For those who are interested, we thought it would be nice to put together a Sunday outing.

On Sunday, September 20th there is a Riverboat Cruise/Sunday Brunch, 12:30-3:00, that the "Gateway Arch Riverboat's" run. This is a 2 hour river boat cruise on the Mississippi.

The cost is \$40.00 per person, \$18.00 for children 3-12. The cost is separate from the reunion registration fees.

<u>Brunch includes</u>: French Toast, Cheese Blintzes, Sausage, Eggs, Prime Rib, Chicken Breast, Vegetable's, Pasta's, Tossed salad, Fruit salad, OJ, Coffee, Ice Tea and Assorted Cakes.

We have 50 seats reserved for this activity; seats can be added based on availability of the River-Boat.

Donations are greatly appreciated to offset the cost for a bus rental.


