# 2019 - 71st SOS Reservists 50th Anniversary Homecoming Reunion Courtesy of Jim Alvis

Thursday June 6, 2019 was a day to remember for 71<sup>st</sup> SOS reservists. Approximately seventy-five reservists and seventy-five family members and guests gathered to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the 71<sup>st</sup>'s return home from Vietnam. The event was the single largest gathering of 71<sup>st</sup> reservists since arriving home on 6 June 1969.

Dixie Wall began to plan for this event last fall and she did a fantastic job. Kudos to Dixie and her helpers and benefactors for making such a memorable event. A lunch was served in the Columbus Municipal Airport Terminal Building followed by a few announcements and the introduction of special guest Lt Col Matt Shrull, Commander of the current day 71<sup>st</sup> SOS at Kirtland AFB, NM. Lt Col Shrull presented a beautiful framed graphic of the CV-22B Osprey tilt-rotor aircraft to the Vietnam era 71<sup>st</sup> SOS. The print will be on display in the Atterbury-Bakalar Air Museum.

A second surprise announcement was made by Nick Firestone, President of the Atterbury-Bakalar Air Museum. He announced the museum is in the process of purchasing a C-119 for static display at the Columbus Municipal Airport. Since the museum was dedicated in 1992 there have been ongoing discussions and a desire to acquire a C-119, since it best represents the longest residing aircraft type at Bakalar from 1942 to 1970.
