## BLIND AUCTION Guidelines FORUM FLOOR

- --In an effort to make the Auction fair to everyone, all bids willbe "blind" that is, all bids will be placed on a separate ticket and placed in the bag marked for each donated item. No one, aside from the bidder and those counting bids, will know who bid how much.
- -- There is no limit to the number of times anyone can bid for any particular item.
- -- The highest bid for each item will be the winning bid.
- -- In the event that there is a tie for the highest bid, the item will go to the traditional auction for bidding.
- --Items receiving no bids will go to the traditional auction as noted above.
- -- Donors may request a minimum bid for their donation.
- -- Any bids not meeting a requested minimum bid will be discarded unless the donor waives that minimum.
- --Items going to the traditional auction, and having a minimum bid, will have that bid as the starting bid, unless waived by the donor.
- --Winning bidders are responsible for contacting the designated association representative for payment prior to the end of the reunion.
- --BIDDING WILL END 90 MIN PRIOR TO THE BANQUET 1630.
