How to Locate Missing and Lost Military Records

Need to find lost or missing records from your time in the military services, a good place to get started is at the National Archives website. To get started go to website **https://www.vetrecs.archives.gov/** or click on the following link: <u>Vetrecs.archives.gov</u> The following are some of the research items one can pursue.

- Research our organizational records
- Search for Veterans Service records
- Request Military Service Records

Military Service Records options:

- Request DD 214/ Separation Documents
- Request Official Military Personnel File (OMPF)
- Request Replacement Medals
- Request Medical and Health Records

When you finish your request, you will get a signature page you must print out and mail to the address on the instructions. If you need help of any type, call Ev at 520-528-9444
