AC-119 Gunship Association members attend AC-130 W Stinger II Retirement Ceremony

On June 1, 2022, the US Air Force officially retired its AC- 130W Stinger II aircraft from the active inventory. Through the courtesy of one of our association's Legacy Squadrons, some AC-119 Association members were there at Cannon AFB in Clovis, NM to observe the ceremony.

The 16th Special Operations Squadron, which flew the AC-130W, invited our association to attend and five members were able to make the trip. Steve Mac Isaac, Everett Sprous, and Don Luke drove in from Arizona, and Jerry Hester and Larry Barbee made the trip from Texas.

They were warmly greeted by 16th SOS squadron members and the squadron commander, Lt. Col Paul Andrews, in the squadron break area where memorabilia, photographs and models of gunships, including AC-119s, and even a copy of our Association's History Book, were displayed.

After the informal get-together, the group crossed the street to the squadron hanger where bleachers and a podium were arranged for the formal ceremony. Two AC-130s were parked In front of the hanger. One was an outgoing AC-130W Stinger II, the other an AC-130J Ghost Rider, the type that now all the gunship squadrons will be the flying.

The Portales High School Band provided talented musical support for the ceremony and after the National Anthem and the "Air Force Song" Lt. Col Andrews spoke of the deployments and achievements of the Stinger II aircraft by tail number. He listed the number of rounds fired by the weapons systems on the airplanes and the "Firsts" for various advances in technologies first tested and proven on the aircraft. He also mentioned the future of the retired airplanes, some to be used as training platforms and some destined for storage. He thanked the attendees for coming, mentioning the Vietnam era Stingers, and introduced the guest speakers, Colonel Taylor, the 27th Special Operations Wing Commander, and Major General Farrell, the Deputy Commanding General of Joint Special Operations Command. Each of these officers spoke briefly. Then the aircrews for the fly-over in the two aircraft were introduced individually, and they did the pre-flight and launched.

After the fly-over, the ceremony was ended and the guests returned to the squadron to be served cake and to say goodbye. Once again, our hats are off for the hospitality of the 16th SOS. Such continued contact and interaction with our legacy active duty units is important to preserve the heritage and traditions of the Airmen who fly the Gunships.
