- d. Ascots/Ties: Gus, Debbie Barbee, Wayne provided several options at Ft Walton.
  - 1) Feedback indicates folks want the Association to procure more, BUT to make them so they'll accommodate the diversity of size necks we've become, from pencil to turtle neck.
  - 2) Task: Debbie Barbee has digital versions of DaNang Stinger & Shadow logos in format used by embroidering machines: Wayne will get those & send to Gus
  - 3) Feedback recommendations: find a company that makes these & procure them
    - a) Dark Blue, Black, & White with embroidered red Stinger (folks liked DaNang Version but should we do actual patch version?) or Shadow (black on white ascot or white on black ascot)
    - b) Wider & longer, with multiple snaps vs Velcro for collars, to accommodate multiple sizes
    - c) Locate Logo so it shows close to neckline when collar is rolled once (rolling the collar makes the logo stand out & be more visible vs tucked away).
  - 4) Ties: Jimmy Montgomery made several black ties with Da Nang Stingers that many folks liked.
    - a) Task: Wayne will ask Jimmy to send Gus the digital file he gave to his embroidery shop, plus other info on the ties he used

        - (2) *Shadow*/17<sup>th</sup>/71<sup>st</sup> Legacy Coin: 71<sup>st</sup> SOS *Shadow*, 71<sup>st</sup> SOS *Osprey*, 17<sup>th</sup> SOS MC-130P *Shadow* 3 Squadron patches on opposite side
