ON 6 JUNE 1970 SSGT CLYDE D. ALLOWAY, AN ILLUMINATOR OPERATOR, WAS A CREWMAN ON AN AC119K AIRCRAFT, (#52-5935, CALL SIGN LEMON 10), THAT CRASHED IN THE GENERAL VICINITY OF GRID COORDINATES (GC) BT 167 840 IN THE SOUTH CHINA SEA. SHORTLY AFTER TAKEDER THE AIRCRAFT DEVELOPED ENGINE TROUBLE AND THE CREW WAS FORCED TO BAIL OUT WITHIN THE VICINITY OF A FOUR MILE RADIUS OF THE SUSPECTED CRASH SITE: LOCATED ABOUT FIVE NAUTICAL MILES NORTHEAST OF DA NANG, SOUTH VIETNAM.

THE LAST KNOWN RADIO CONTACT WITH SSGT ALLOWAY INDICATED THAT HE WAS TANGLED IN HIS PARACHUTE AND NEEDED IMMEDIATE AID. HOWEVER, HE COULD NOT BE LOCATED BY SEARCH AND RESCUE (SAR) FORCES. SAR EFFORTS RECOVERED NINE OF THE TEN PERSONS ABOARD THE AIRCRAFT, BUT NO TRACE OF SSGT ALLOWAY COULD BE FOUND. (REF 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5)

DURING THE EXISTENCE OF JCRC, THE HOSTILE THREAT IN THE AREA PRECLUDED ANY VISITS TO OR GROUND INSPECTIONS OF THE SITE INVOLVED IN THIS CASE. THIS INDIVIDUAL'S NAME AND IDENTIFYING DATA WERE TURNED OVER TO THE FOUR-PARTY JOINT MILITARY TEAM WITH A REQUEST FOR ANY INFORMATION AVAILABLE INFORMATION. NO RESPONSE WAS FORTHCOMING. SSGT ALLOWAY IS CURRENTLY CARRIED IN THE PRESUMPTIVE STATUS OF DEAD, REMAINS NON-RECOVERABLE.
