Our policy on KIA family is that the **first time** the KIA Family member designated as the Honorary Member attends a reunion, we cover their registration for the 3 major events (Meet & Greet, Banquet, & Farewell) & their hotel room (we try to use comped rooms for this). That Honorary designee isn't always the Mother or Father. It can be a Brother, Sister, Daughter, Son, or even Cousin (James Vangelisti) depending on "who" we've been able to locate & contact.

This expanded over the years to include all the KIA family members who attend that Reunion. As a result, it isn't always the same cost since it has ranged from one person & one room (Kirstin Giroux – Tom Hamman's daughter) all the way to 9 people & 5 rooms (Mae Rucker, O'Neal's 3 siblings & spouses, plus Tia McConnell & her father).

After the first reunion they attend, we don't cover anything on costs – only their first reunion.
