November is peak tourist time for the hotel so our original price is now even a greater bargain for hotel rooms & meals. Our Reunion Hotel's corporate plans to renovate their convention rooms were delayed for two years due to COVID. They are now catching up & our Crystal City Hilton is scheduled to be renovated from August to early October. You might see the hotel name listed as Hilton Crystal City – or – Hilton Arlington National Landing. They're the same hotel; the renovation includes renaming it to Hilton Arlington National Landing. For those driving to the reunion, fall colors will be in their full glory into early November. And lodging does include breakfast buffet for two!

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 8

0900 - 1630 City Tour (\$72 per person includes bus & guide): See the sites of our nation's capital during a driving tour of Washington, D.C. Ride by the Lincoln Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, WWII Memorial, the Mall, Capitol Building, Washington Monument, White House, & other notable monuments & federal buildings. Free time will be allowed at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. Afterward, stop at the Ronald Reagan Building & International Trade Center, which is the largest building (3.1 million square ft) in Washington, DC & is the first & only federal building dedicated to both government & private use. While there, enjoy lunch on your own at the Reagan Building food court - named one of the "best family food courts" in DC. Following lunch, head to the National Museum of the Navy. This flagship museum is located in the former Breech Mechanism Shop of the old Naval Gun Factory on the grounds of the Washington Navy Yard. Explore permanent & temporary exhibits including Steel Navy, Great White Fleet & more. Be sure to stop in the Gift Shop where Navy themed items are available. A photo ID is required for entrance to the Ronald Reagan Building & National Museum of the Navy. 0900, board bus, 1630 back at the hotel. Lunch on your own.

1300 - 1600 Arlington National Cemetery & Vietnam Veteran's Memorial Tour (\$61 per person includes bus & escort): Board the bus for a trip to Arlington National Cemetery. There, board an open-air tram with stops at President John F. Kennedy gravesite, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Iwo Jima Gate, General Pershing Gravesite & Arlington House. Enjoy time on your own to visit the Welcome Center upon arrival & before you depart. Next stop will be to visit the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. This US national memorial honors service members of the U.S. armed forces who fought in the Vietnam War. In the same area you can also visit the Vietnam Women's memorial, Korean War Veterans Memorial & the World War II Memorial. 1300 Board bus, 1630 back at hotel. *A valid state or government issued photo ID is required for entrance to Arlington Cemetery 1500 - 1900 Reunion Registration Open

0930 - 1500 Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center Tour (\$52 per person includes bus & escort): This museum, part of the Smithsonian Institution's National Air & Space Museum, is dedicated to the preservation & display of its collection of historic aviation & space artifacts. Located in Chantilly, VA, the facility has large aviation & space exhibit hangars. The museum currently has over eighty aircraft & dozens of space artifacts on display including the Space Shuttle Discovery, an SR-71 Blackbird, Boeing 367-80 Jet Transport, Concorde, Fox Alpha, Air France, Martin B-26B-25 MA Marauder "Flak-Bait" & the B-29 Superfortress "Enola Gay." For lunch, enjoy Shake Shack favorites including burgers, hotdogs, chicken sandwiches & fries. Don't forget your shake, including two shakes exclusive to the Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center only. Pre-packaged salads & sandwiches are also available. You may tour the exhibits at your own pace, but there is a lot of walking, so please wear comfortable shoes. 0930 board bus, 1500 back at the hotel. Lunch on your own.

1030 - 1430 Odyssey Lunch Cruise (\$107/per person includes bus, escort, & lunch cruise): Enjoy a two-hour lunch cruise with live entertainment, narration, & a plated lunch, onboard the Odyssey DC, a one-level climate-controlled, glass-enclosed vessel. Elegantly sailing North under the low bridges of DC for up close views of the monuments. Relax while you cruise the historic water of the District of Columbia, Maryland, & Virginia. Your captain will point out landmarks like the Washington Monument, Ft. McNair, Washington National Airport, General's Row, & Old Towne Alexandria. 
