The resort fee of \$29 is waived for rooms booked in our group block. But you MUST Reserve by October 20th for our guaranteed rate. Since you can cancel without charge up to 48 hours prior to your reservation check-in date, reserve your room now to guarantee you get our Reunion rate. You can also upgrade to Pool View at \$186 or Gulf View at \$230 based on availability. 





