TOUR DESCRIPTIONS

Wednesday, November 8, 2023:

CITY TOUR

See the sites of our nation's capital during a driving tour of Washington, D.C. Ride by the Lincoln Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, WWII Memorial, the Mall, Capitol Building, Washington Monument, White House, and other notable monuments and federal buildings. Free time will be allowed at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. Afterward, stop at the Ronald Reagan Building and International Trade Center, which is the largest building (3.1 million square feet) in Washington, DC and is the first and only federal building dedicated to both government and private use. While there, enjoy lunch on your own at the Reagan Building food court - named one of the "best family food courts" in DC. Following lunch, head to the National Museum of the Navy. This flagship museum is located in the former Breech Mechanism Shop of the old Naval Gun Factory on the grounds of the Washington Navy Yard. Explore permanent and temporary exhibits including Steel Navy, Great White Fleet and more. Be sure to stop in the Gift Shop where Navy themed items are available.

A photo ID is required for entrance to the Ronald Reagan Building and National Museum of the Navy.

ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY AND VIETNAM VETERAN'S MEMORIAL

Board the bus for a trip to Arlington National Cemetery. There, board an open-air tram with stops at President John F. Kennedy gravesite, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Iwo Jima Gate, General Pershing Gravesite and Arlington House. Enjoy time on your own to visit the Welcome Center upon arrival and before you depart. Next stop will be to visit the Vietnam Veterans Memorial. This US national memorial honors service members of the U.S. armed forces who fought in the Vietnam War. In the same area you can also visit the Vietnam Women's memorial, Korean War Veterans Memorial and the World War II Memorial.

Thursday, November 9, 2023:

STEVEN F. UDVAR-HAZY CENTER

This museum, part of the Smithsonian Institution's National Air and Space Museum, is dedicated to the preservation and display of its collection of historic aviation and space artifacts. Located in Chantilly, VA, the facility has large aviation and space exhibit hangars. The museum currently has over eighty aircraft and dozens of space artifacts on display including the Space Shuttle Discovery, an SR-71 Blackbird, Boeing 367-80 Jet Transport, Concorde, Fox Alpha, Air France, Martin B-26B-25 MA Marauder "Flak-Bait" and the B-29 Superfortress "Enola Gay." For lunch, enjoy Shake Shack favorites including burgers, hotdogs, chicken sandwiches and fries. Don't forget your shake, including two shakes exclusive to the Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center only. Pre-packaged salads and sandwiches are also available. You may tour the exhibits at your own pace, but there is a lot of walking, so please wear comfortable shoes.

ODYSSEY LUNCH CRUISE

Enjoy a two-hour lunch cruise with live entertainment, narration, and a plated lunch, onboard the Odyssey DC, a one-level climate-controlled, glass-enclosed vessel. Elegantly sailing North under the low bridges of Washington, DC for up close views of the monuments. Relax while you cruise the historic water of the District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia.
